We treat children between birth and their entrance into kindergarten who have a variety of developmental delays and disabilities, including but not limited to the following:

- Speech/language disorders
- Developmental delays
- Prematurity
- Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder
- Autism spectrum disorders
- Down syndrome
- Cerebral palsy
- Sensory processing disorder

We also treat children, adolescents, and parents who have mental health needs including but not limited to:

- Adjustment disorders
- Anxiety disorders
- Mood Disorders

Our Program

The Child and Family Support Program is a home, center, and community-based program that provides occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech therapy, caregiver training, as well as mental health counseling for children and their families living in the Baltimore Metropolitan area. We also assist eligible Baltimore City infants and toddlers and their families by providing service coordination.

Services We Offer

Our team provides a wide variety of services, including:

- Home, center and community-based occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech therapy evaluations and treatment for children from birth until their entrance into kindergarten
- A range of therapeutic interventions [i.e. sensory integration, neurodevelopmental treatment, manual therapy, oral-motor feeding therapy]
- Service Coordination for Baltimore City Infants and Toddlers eligible families
- Training for parents in the skills that will assist them in caring for their child in the home
- Information concerning their child's development
- Evaluation, adaptation, and monitoring of specialized equipment needs in the home
- Home and center-based mental health counseling for children, adolescents and parents
- Effective interventions to enhance caregiver/child attachment for caregivers and their young children
- Assistance in accessing community resources
- A toy, book and equipment lending library

Therapy can be provided in the family's home, our center, schools, child care centers, Head Starts, or any other places that are significant in the child's life. Services are provided by appointment, with daytime and limited early evening hours available. Medical assistance and private insurance reimbursements are both accepted.
